Changes Coming to Youth Soccer in 2016

SMALL-SIDED STANDARDS

The small-sided standards are focused at players from the U-6 to U-12 age groups. The field dimensions and number of players on the pitch will increase in size from 4v4 to 7v7 to 9v9 as players age, up until they reach the U-13 age group and begin to play full 11v11 matches.

BIRTH-YEAR REGISTRATION

Birth-year registration calendars will now align with the start of the calendar year and run from January to December, rather than August to July as it had previously. For example, a U-15 player (players 15 years old or younger) would have a birth year of 2000 (Jan. 1 through Dec. 31) for the 2015 registration year. In 2016, U-15 players would be born in 2001 or earlier. Birth-year registration applies to all player age groups and not just players age 12 and younger. The initiative will align registration with the international standard, while simultaneously providing clearer information on player birth dates to combat 'relative age effect'.

Birth Year and Season Matrix

When determining the age group for a season, the year the season ends should be used for determining the birth year. Also note that the format "U followed by age" really means that age and younger. Information that is still needed:

- 1. League Plans for implementation (ie WAGS, NCSL):
 - a. Will Play-up rules be changed?
 - i. Impacts U9-U12 where there are currently limits per team
 - a. U9-U10 allow 2 players on the roster to be "playing up"
 - b. U11-U12 allow 3 players to play up
 - c. >U13 no restrictions

ASA's Current Plans

•Rec program:

- Start implementation Spring 2016
- New teams will follow the birth year age groups as much as possible
- Exceptions will be evaluated individually

ASA's Current Plans (con't)

•County & Travel:

- Implementation August 2016
- Birth year age groups will be followed at June 2016 evaluations
- Play dates will be scheduled (all teams in each age)
- Coaches will be consulted on the year they plan to coach (ie most will coach their child's year)
- Higher level travel teams will be reviewed individually with the coaches to determine what, if any, change is needed
